NSBA Saanen Specialty Show Rules

1. Any individual or club from any District may apply for NSBA District Specialties
2. Saanens must be separately sanctioned
3. Shows wishing to hold an NSBA District Specialty cannot be restricted in any way. The show must be open to all breeders in the district as well as adjacent districts. Any money or prizes offered by the club, state or local authority must be paid to any winner regardless of where they reside.
4. Application fee is \$50. \$25 is refunded to the host club when the NSBA Specialty results and photos are provided to the NSBA Specialty Shows Chair. \$25 will be retained by NSBA to help defray program expenses. Makes checks payable to "National Saanen Breeders Association" or "NSBA" and send with application to the NSBA Specialty Shows Chair, identified below.
5. NSBA will provide a rosette for Grand, Reserve, and 1st Place Group Classes; and an award to be chosen by the committee for Best of Breed.
6. The host group agrees to supply a list of the first 3 placings of each class and the photos listed below in (7.) within 60 days of the completion of the show.
7. Required photos: 1st place of each age class, Grand Champion, Reserve Champion, Best of Breed, 1st place of each group class. Photos must be labeled with animal's registered name. Photos will be retained by NSBA for use in news releases.
8. Winners will be published on the NSBA website, and on the NSBA Members Facebook page.
9. Applications are accepted from Oct 1st through Jan 31st for shows in January's year.
10. Only one NSBA Specialty Show per ADGA/NSBA District will be awarded.
11. Selected sites will be notified no later than February 15th
12. Specialty sites selected must have one of the following statements on the show flyer "NSBA SAANEN SPECIALTY IS NOT SEPARATELY SANCTIONED" If offering an additional ring that is a separately sanctioned show, then add the following on the show flyer "NSBA SAANEN SPECIALTY IS SEPARATELY SANCTIONED"

Criteria for selecting a Specialty Site

1. The first club to apply gets the Specialty for that District, unless: A. The same show hosted the Specialty the past year. B. The show is in the same state as the past year. C. The show offers only two sanctions versus a show offering three (Example: Senior Doe, Junior Doe, Buck). D. The show offers a combined Junior-Senior show instead of Junior Does and Senior Does separately sanctioned. E. The show offers fewer group classes than a show offering the same amount of sanctions.
2. All else being equal in regards to sanctions offered, preference is given to shows that have a larger reported number of Saanens shown the previous year. 3. When previous host clubs are applying, a club whose reports had been returned complete, neat and in a timely manner will be given preference over a club whose report response was inadequate from a previous year.
